Subject: information on the processing of your personal data pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679

Pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003, the Personal Data Protection Code (hereinafter the "Code") and Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679 on Data Protection, this is to inform you that your personal data will be processed by the Data Controller indicated below.

For the sake of clarity, the following definitions are provided:

2. OBJECT, PURPOSE, AND LEGAL BASIS OF PROCESSING

a. **Purpose and Object**: to respond as effectively as possible to your requests made via our web form.

Legal basis of processing (lawfulness): This processing falls within the scope of lawful processing, pursuant to article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679 governing Data Protection

- third-party companies or other third parties to which activities have been outsourced by the Data Controller, in their capacity as external data processors, specifically appointed and authorised for specific processing operations.

Legal basis of processing (lawfulness): This processing falls within the scope of lawful processing, pursuant to article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679 governing Data Protection

Category of subjects who may become aware of personal data - Recipients -:

Your Personal Data may be made accessible, for the purposes indicated above or in compliance with legal obligations or for carrying out activities instrumental to the aforementioned purposes, to:

- employees of the Data Controller, specifically appointed and authorised for this purpose, also in the capacity of data processors, for specific processing operations;
- third-party companies or other third parties to which activities have been outsourced by the Data Controller, in their capacity as external data processors, specifically appointed and authorised for specific processing operations.

The agreements signed with the latter are designed to permit only essential processing and to guarantee the confidentiality, security, and integrity of the data.

Type of data: all the personal data entered in the web purchase form

Legal basis of processing (lawfulness): This processing falls within the scope of lawful processing pursuant to article 130, paragraph 4, of Legislative Decree No. 196 of 30 June 2003, the "Data Protection Code", supplemented with the amendments introduced by Legislative Decree No. 101 of 10 August 2018

Category of subjects who may become aware of personal data - Recipients -:

Your Personal Data may be made accessible, for the purposes indicated above or in compliance with legal obligations or for carrying out activities instrumental to the aforementioned purposes, to:

- employees of the Data Controller, specifically appointed and authorised for this purpose, also in the capacity of data processors, for specific processing operations;
- third-party companies or other third parties to which activities have been outsourced by the Data Controller, in their capacity as external data processors, specifically appointed and authorised for specific processing operations.

The agreements signed with the latter are designed to permit only essential processing and to guarantee the confidentiality, security, and integrity of the data.

Legal basis of processing (lawfulness): The processing of your personal data is legitimate, as it is the consequence of your explicit, freely-given consent pursuant to article 6, paragraph 1, letter A of Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679, indicated by ticking the optional check box before sending the web form

Category of subjects who may become aware of personal data - Recipients -:

Your Personal Data may be made accessible, for the purposes indicated above or in compliance with legal obligations or for carrying out activities instrumental to the aforementioned purposes, to:

- employees of the Data Controller, specifically appointed and authorised for this purpose, also in the capacity of data processors, for specific processing operations;
- third-party companies or other third parties to which activities have been outsourced by the Data Controller, in their capacity as external data processors, specifically appointed and authorised for specific processing operations.

The agreements signed with the latter are designed to permit only essential processing and to guarantee the confidentiality, security, and integrity of the data.

3. DURATION OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

The data shall be kept until the purpose for their processing ceases to be valid, and as long as a right of the data subject or of the Data Controller to the processing of personal data can be asserted.

Periodic checks on data obsolescence are carried out.

4. TOOLS AND PRINCIPLES APPLIED TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

In relation to the purposes referred to herein, processing is carried out by means of manual, IT, and electronic tools, applying principles strictly related to the aforementioned purposes and, in any case, in such a way as to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data.

5. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

All the rights mentioned below can be exercised using the contact details of the Data Controller given at the beginning of the document, in paragraph 1

- Right to request access to your personal data from the Data Controller
- Right to request the rectification / deletion / restriction of your personal data from the Data Controller

6. TRANSFER OF DATA ABROAD

Your Personal Data will normally be processed within the European Union and stored on servers located within the European Union.
